
14.7% decrease in the number of train accidents during the First half of 2019

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics (CAPMAS) issued today 3/12/2019

Car and Train accidents report in the first half of 2019. The most important indicators were as follows:

Car accidents:

- Number of car accidents on all roads reached 5220 accidents in the first half of 2019, compared to 4426 accidents in the same period in 2018, an increase of 17.9% resulting in 1567 deaths, 6046 injured and 8335 damaged vehicles.
- Number of injured in accidents roads increased to 6046 in the first half of 2019, compared to 5936 in the Same period in 2018, an increase of 1.9%.
- Accident rate increased to 870 (accident / month) in the first half of 2019 compared to 738 (accident / month) in the same period in 2018.



- Accident Severity rate reached 1.5 (deaths or injured/ accident) and accidents Cruelty rate reached 25.9 (deceased / 100 injured) in the first half of 2019
- January witnessed the highest number of accidents, with 968 accident, representing 18.5%, followed by May 917 accidents for 17.6% of total accidents in the first half of 2019.

Train accidents:

- Number of train accidents dropped to 923, in the first half of 2019, compared to 1082, a decrease of 14.7% In the same period in 2018
- -The highest number of accidents at lower egypt (Delta) reached 540 accidents by 58.5%, followed by Upper Egypt 240 accidents 26% followed by central region 143 accidents 15.5% of the total accidents in the regions.
- Accidents cruelty rate dropped to 29.3 in the first half of 2019 from 66.0 in the same period in 2018
- Death rate was 4.5 (deaths / month), and injured rate was 15.3 (injured / month) in the first half of 2019.
